



Donor Privacy Policy

Support from individual donors, corporations, foundations, volunteers, and public funders is critical to NMAC's work. Our shared commitment to end the HIV epidemic serves as the cornerstone of our relationship with our supporters. NMAC respects the privacy of its donors and has put in place a Donor Privacy Policy to honor these relationships.

I. NMAC collects and maintains the following types of donor information:

- Contact information including name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address
- Giving information and history of involvement
- Specific program or funding interests
- Other comments or suggestions, relevant to the donor

This confidential information is kept on file to comply with IRS guidelines. This information is shared internally on a confidential, and need-to-know basis.

II. NMAC does not sell, rent, trade, or share its donor list with any other organization.

III. NMAC honors donor preferences with regard to the method and frequency of communication.
