Essential Duties & Responsibilities

Includes the following:

- Understands and implements operating policies and procedures.
- Conducts HIV Pre and Post Test Counseling.
- Elicits from clients HIV risk history including, but not limited to, demographic information, sex history, drug and alcohol use, and past STD infections.
- Administers oral or fingerstick tests to detect HIV antibodies.
- Collects and processes specimen samples in accordance with National, State, and Local guidelines.
- Provides health education and individual risk reduction counseling sessions.
- Promotes healthy sexual behaviors and praises risk reduction plans adopted by clients.
- Conducts test result disclosure and post disclosure counseling as needed and required.
- Offer clients local community and medical referrals as needed.
- Documents all required information for reporting purposes.
- Other duties may be requested as needed.

Attends testing counselors meeting. Attends other meetings as assigned.
